What are Learning Stories?

Learning Stories are strength-based narratives that celebrate learning, often written to your child. Each story includes: an event or moment, with teacher ideas and reflections on learning and on next steps.

Learning stories are personal and heart-led. An informal tone makes the learning easier for everybody to digest and understand, enabling them to respond meaningfully.

Why Learning Stories

- Storytelling is personal and familiar for teachers - making the sharing authentic. Stories are easy to write.
- Stories allow teachers to express their feelings and fully capture the event - tell the backstory, add context, etc.
- Stories brings everybody around your child closer together.
- The need to write stories helps our teachers observe your child closely, it's a better process to help understand each child.
- Learning Stories become a treasured keepsake.
